1. Representatives of political parties from inside Burma and the UNFC held a meeting and had discussions cordially and freely in Chiangmai on November 22, 2013.
2. Representatives from the National Democratic Force, Democratic Party (Myanmar), Democracy and Peace Party, Shan Nationalities Democratic Party, Rakhine Nationalities Development Party, Karen People's Party, Chin Progressive Party, Chin National Party, Shan Nationalities League for Democracy, Diversity and Peace Party and National League for Democracy and, on the other hand, the central committee members of the UNFC and representatives of other alliances attended the meeting.
3. Representatives of the two sides cordially and frankly exchanged views, enquire about and analysed the latest situation regarding progress in peace effort and the effort for building a Federal Union.
4. Such a meeting is an activity that supports in the discovery of answers to problems relating to the 60-year long civil war and the constitutional law. The two sides arrived at the firm position for continuing the collaborative effort in striving for peace and in stages of activities to build a genuine federal union.
