1. On the invitation of Union Minister U Aung Min, a cabinet member of the Union Government, a 5-man UNFC delegation, including 3 UNFC leaders, paid a visit to Rangoon/Yangon from November 23 to 26, 2013, and the visiting program was concluded successfully today.
2. During its visit, the delegation met with leaders of the United Nationalities Alliance (UNA), National Brotherhood Federation (NBF), the democratic icon of Burma/Myanmar, Daw Aung San Suu Kyi, the 88-Generation leaders, Peace and Open Society, some veteran politicians, ethnic civil society leaders, and the Peace Donor Support Group (PDSG), which is an international community supporting the ongoing peace process. The UNFC views the visit as an event in support of the ongoing peace process and the process of establishing a future federal Union.
3. The UNFC is much grateful to the Union Minister U Aung Min and officials of the Myanmar Peace Center, the Japanese Government's Special Envoy for National Reconciliation in Myanmar, H. E. Yohei Sasakawa, The Nippon Foundation, the respective political parties and individuals – those who have mainly helped to make the visit a success.
