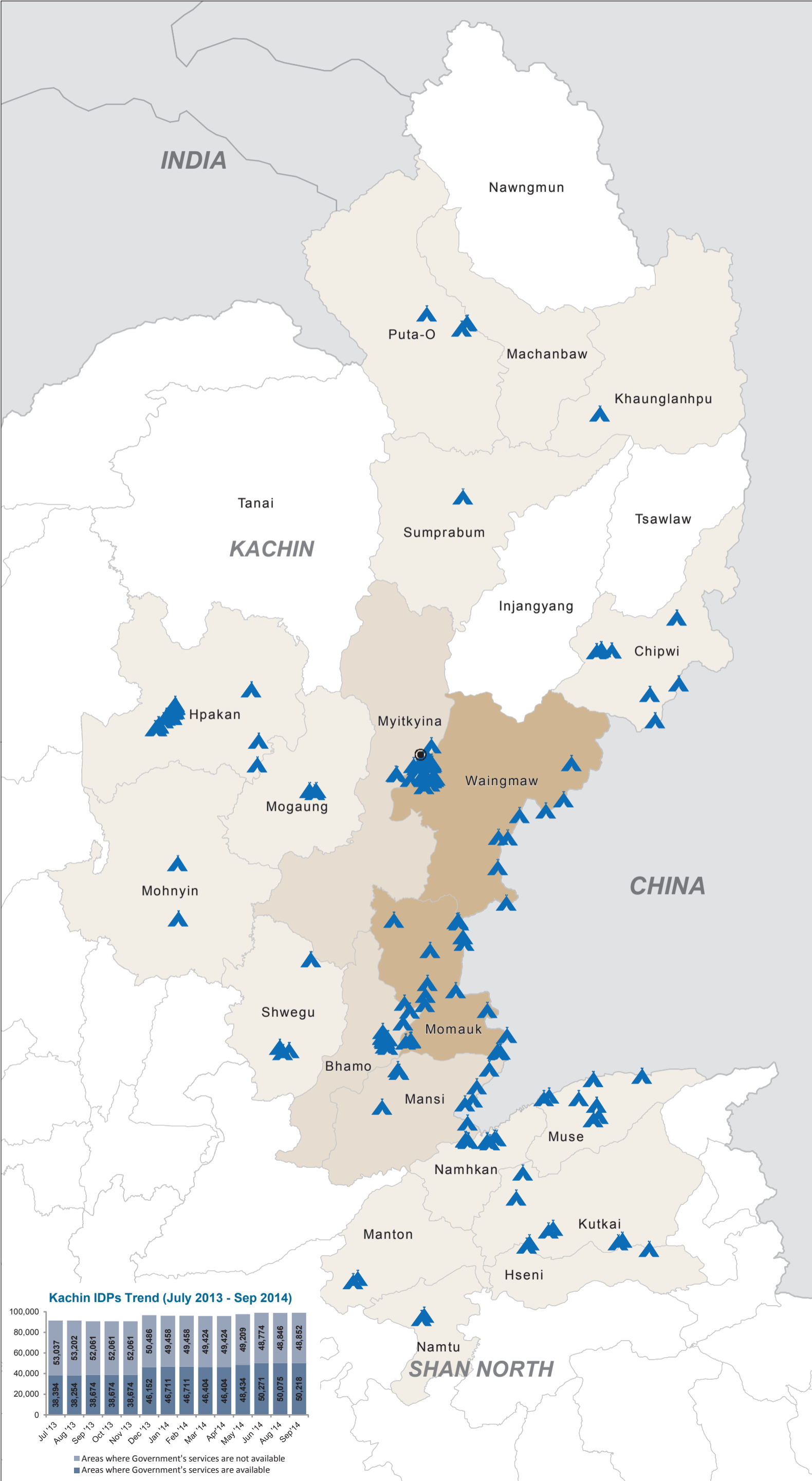


# Myanmar: Internal Displacement in Kachin and northern Shan States

- State Capital

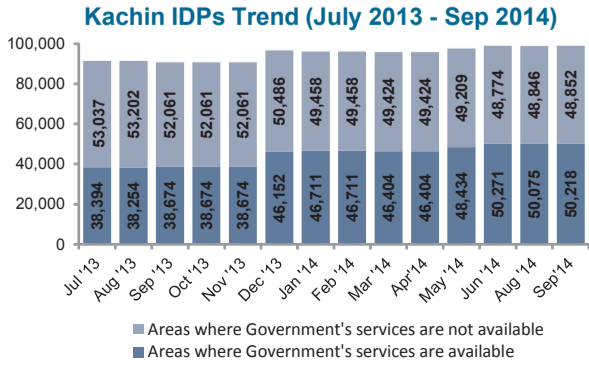
